Wayne and Joy are both volunteer chaplains in Farmington, Missouri, one in a state prison and one in a mental health center. Wayne was born in Nashville, Tennessee, and Joy was born in Lawrence, Massachusetts. Each of their families moved to the same neighborhood in California, where they were raised and subsequently earned degrees in micro biology and computer science. They grew up in families that were very religious and active in church, which clearly had a strong impact on their lives.

Wayne and Joy were married 44 years ago and have three children, six grandchildren and one great grandchild. For 10 years in California, they started food pantries and soup kitchens that served the poor and homeless in the downtown area of Los Angeles known as Watts. About ten years ago, they felt the Lord encouraging them into prison ministry in Missouri. Wayne focuses on the Farmington Correctional Center, while Joy provides grief counseling, church services and Bible studies in the forensic sector of the Southeast Missouri Mental Health Center.
