Urban St. Louis K-Life - "Rescuing Inner City Youth"

Jason grew up in Knoxville, TN, where he was named Tennessee High School Football Player of the Year in 1986. He then played football at the University of Tennessee, participating in two SEC championships and three bowl games.

Eventually Jason came to St. Louis to study at Covenant Theological Seminary, where he received an M.A. cum laude in Theology in 2000. In 2005 he founded Urban K-Life, a ministry that targets young teens of St. Louis' inner city through athletic coaching, academic assistance, and life skills development inside the city high schools. UKL currently has dedicated staff at four St. Louis city high schools, where they serve about 400 students, and has a growing influence at six other schools. UKL also operates an activity center at 2900 N Prairie Ave.

Jason and his wife Mary have three amazing children, Joshua, Isaiah, and Genesis, ages 7 thru 11, and they live in the community they serve.

Imagine a time when all children growing up in impoverished, broken homes in St. Louis' inner city can become high achievers in school and on the athletic field, based on intentional life-on-life discipleship from Christian mentors; and then those same students return to disciple the next generation of students. That is both the vision and the growing reality of Jason Julian and Urban St. Louis K-Life. Join us on March 21 to learn about this amazing ministry.


