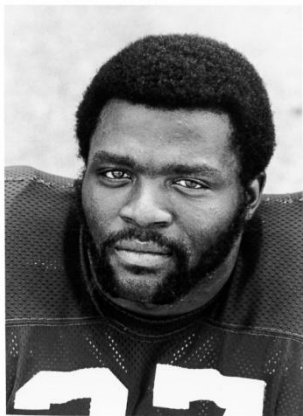

EDDIE MOSS

Eddie Moss grew up on a small farm outside Poplar Bluff as one of 15 children born to Jordan “JD” and Willie Marie Moss. And there wasn’t much time for sports.

However, a series of events eventually would transform Moss from a basketball hopeful into the featured blocking back for the Cardinals’ great Terry Metcalf. Moss emerged, in order, as an all-conference fullback for Poplar Bluff, then a standout rusher for Southeast Missouri State before earning the starting fullback job with Don Coryell’s St. Louis Football Cardinals. And, with Moss aboard, the Cardinals reached the NFL playoffs three consecutive years.

Moss played for the Cardinals from 1973-1976, helping St. Louis to playoff seasons his final three years. He finished his NFL career with the Washington Redskins in 1977 and 1978. The Missouri Sports Hall of Fame inducted Moss with the Class of 2016.

After his NFL days, Moss worked 27 years for the United Parcel Service in St. Louis, where he and his wife, Phyllis, raised daughters Deborah and Amanda Lynn and son Brian.

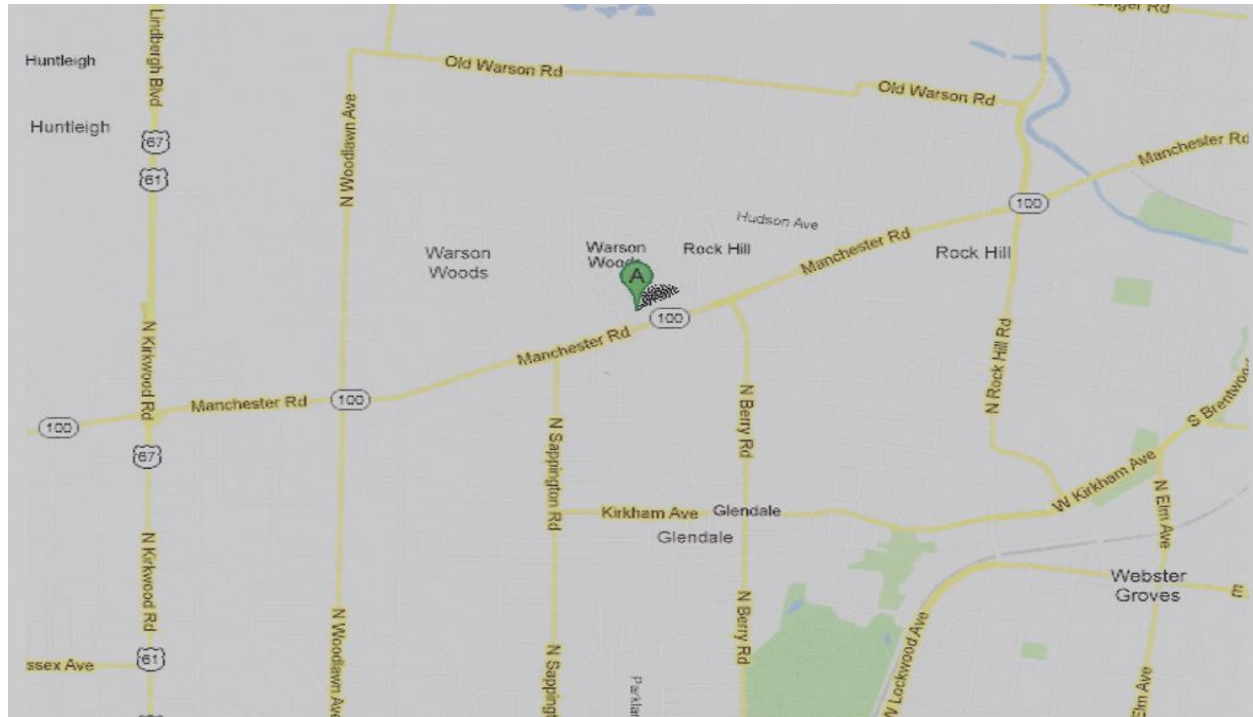
